DCPS Summer School is available at no cost to any DC resident student regardless of whether the student attended a public, public charter,

catholic or private school during the regular school year. Students who take a "non-Carnegie" unit course can earn \$7.25 per hour while

attending class. Students do not earn money for taking courses that

provide Carnegie unit credits towards graduation. (Examples of Carnegie unit credits are courses in English, Foreign Languages, Math, Science,

etc. Summer school is from June 28th through August 6th (5 days per

week); 3 hours per day, Students (18 yrs and younger) should apply

through their school counselor or at the Luke C. Moore HS, 1001
